Lunch at Alma de Colores in San Juan. Afternoon visit with Nan Maria, Mayan Spiritual Leader, for a Mayan Ceremony for gratitude for the trip. Boat back over to Panajachel. Dinner and overnight in Panajachel.

Lunch at the church and drive back to Chichicastenango. Freetime and rest in the afternoon. Dinner and overnight in Chichicastenango.

Sun, March 24: CHICHICASTENANGO/ANTIGUA: Breakfast at Hotel, morning visit to the market in Chichicastenango. Lunch and drive to Antigua. Easter procession in Antigua in the evening. Overnight in Antigua.

Mon, March 25: ANTIGUA: Final day in Antigua. Morning visit to Las Cappucinas, an ancient convent ruin. Lunch together and afternoon freetime. Closing celebration and dinner.
